The most effective way to communicate with teachers is to leave a message in the education office. Texting and social-media is not good practice.



Using social media, WhatsApp or the like to discuss students or faculty is not appropriate.

You can expect a response via phone within 48 hours (excluding holidays & weekends).



Create a "H.W. Buddy" for forgotten H.W. or it's explanation. Alternatively, call or email a friend. Please respect teacher privacy.



When indicated, daily or weekly reports may be implemented in consultation with the principals.

Where



Teacher responsibilities during the school day precludes discussions.



Discussions regarding students should only be done in privacy. Never in a public setting.



Teachers cannot provide all class work materials to accommodate vacation absences.
