DISMISSAL PROCEDURE FOR PARENTS (NO BUSES PLAN) – FRIDAY

Same Procedures, Different times!

- ▶ At 12:40 PM, students in grades 1 – 4 will be divided by class / cohort to an assigned, and distanced, corner in the Hoffman Auditorium. **Everyone will be required to wear a mask.**
- ▶ At 12:40 PM, Grades 5 – 8 will remain in their classrooms.
- ▶ At 12:40 PM, Preschool will be waiting under a tent in the playground.

They will be separated by class / cohort. Everyone will be required to wear a mask.

- ▶ Rabbi Chanales will greet cars / drivers on Nostrand Ave. ...
- ▶ Mr. Goldstein will greet cars / drivers on E. 29th St. ...
...to get the names of students in that carpool.
- ▶ Parents are asked to follow these simple guidelines to help mitigate road / parking congestion and expedite the dismissal process:
 - **IMPORTANT: “YDH Carpool Passenger List.”** Due to the need for social distancing, **we will require drivers to provide a written list (as legible as possible) of the students who you will be transporting that day**, in this order...

 - Drivers whose last name begins with letters **A – K, line up on Nostrand Ave.**
 - Drivers whose last name begins with letters **L – Z, line up on E. 29th St.**
 - **Please leave space for our neighbors’ driveways!**
- ▶ Students of a given carpool and / or siblings will all be notified simultaneously, via radio.
- ▶ Students left behind on the “**rare**” occasion of a late pickup, will be supervised where they are (Hoffman, Tent, or Classroom).

Cars will be approached on a first come / first served basis. Please be patient, this may take a bit longer than usual but it is in the interest of our students’ safety and accurate processing!
